

What is Making Tax Digital (MTD)?



- Businesses will be mandated to keep digital VAT records and send returns using MTD compatible software.
- No more manual input or submission by spreadsheet.
- Comes into effect on the first tax reporting period on or after April 2019.
- Tax deadlines stay the same, only the method of submission changes.



Who does it affect?



- VAT registered businesses with a taxable turnover above the VAT threshold (£85,000)
- Everybody in this room.
- Including:
 - Self employed Professionals
 - Landlords
 - Charities



Why is this legislation coming into place?



- More effective, efficient and easier for taxpayers to get their tax right.
- Eliminates avoidable tax mistakes.
- More accuracy using digital records.
- Direct submission eliminates transportation errors.
- Eliminates paper based processes, freeing time.
- Leads to all tax being reported this way.



What impact will it have on your business?

Value Added Tax	
1 VAT due on sales and other outputs	1,255.80
2 VAT due on acquisitions from other EC states	0.00
3 Total VAT due	1,255.80
4 VAT reclaimed on acquisitions and other inputs	86.00
5 Net VAT to be paid to HMRC or reclaimed	1,169.80
6 Value of sales and all other outputs excl.any VAT	18,090.00
7 Value of acqu. and all other inputs excl.any VAT	430.00
8 Val.of sales and all other outputs excl.any VAT-EC st	0.00
9 Val.of acqu. and all other inputs excl. any VAT-EC st	0.00

- By April 2019 you will need to be compliant with this new law.
- You face penalty points for non compliance.
- There will be a grace period up until April 2020, however it is important to adhere as soon as possible.

How Priority has adapted?

- R Value Added Tax
- F Connection Details-Online VAT
- F VAT Transmission Log
- P Submit VAT Return
- P Record URL for VAT Transmission
- P Delete URL for VAT Transmission
- R Responses from HMRC

- As of version 18.1, Priority has provided the functionality required to achieve online VAT submissions.
- Priority is registered on HMRC website as an approved commercial software provider for MTD:
- https://www.gov.uk/government/publications/vat-returns-andec-sales-list-commercial-software-suppliers/vat-commercialsoftware-suppliers
- Built in VAT report in the standard VAT100 format.
- Automatic submission procedures.

Step One Make sure you are running at least Priority version 18.1



- Standard upgrade route.
- Contact the VAT team for an upgrade quote.
- 18.1 is supported with a patch.
- 18.2 and 18.3 are fully supported.
- Out of hours upgrade availability is limited and offered on a first come, first serve basis.



Step Two Set-up of the VAT report



- Make sure your VAT report boxes are being correctly populated:
 - Set up VAT report in house.
 - Group Training at Medatech Offices up and down the country. Limited spaces available: http://medatech.com/vattraining-course-calendar-2018-2019/
 - On-site training and set up.
